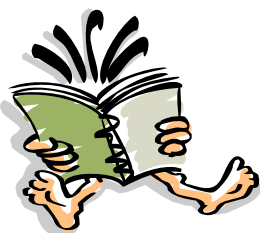


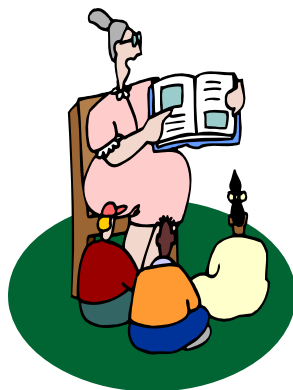
Settle Down Poems and Songs
